Two patented features that make CMI ShoreGuard the best option for your project are; the patented I-Beam Interlock and the 24" box profile. The patented I-Beam Interlock design is optimized to provide lock integrity and maximum stiffness during high-impact installations. The unique patented 24" box profile allows for faster installation and minimal seepage.

All of these features combine with the 50 year warrantee to make ShoreGuard the best material for residential sea walls. The applications are much broader than just residential sea walls. Other applications include protecting roads and highways from erosion of the shoulder where rivers and streams are nearby, or raising freeboard of a levee system. ShoreGuard is an economically feasible solution to increase the height, stability, and overall integrity of levees.
