New Years Eve: 3 different times, NOAA changed the forecasted height from the original 37 feet on Monday, December 28th to 44 feet at 11:00 am Tuesday December 29th. At that point, we quickly realized we were switching from putting things to higher ground to bugging out. We didn't know what height we were in trouble at but based on the Geological survey, we were pretty sure we were in trouble at 44 feet. At 3:00 am on December 31st, the river crested at 44.11 feet in Valley Park, just up stream from us.

New Years Day: On New Years Day, we determined that 11" of water entered the building. Everything in the office and warehouse 11" and below had to be removed, including drywall, built in furniture, inventory, fixtures, etc. On Saturday January 2nd, we removed everything from the warehouse so the mud and contamination could be removed. Our restoration company, ServPro, removed all the mud and debris, sanitized the floors and walls, and on Sunday, we returned all inventory to the warehouse. On Monday, January 4th, we were open for business and had walk-in business and deliveries to do. Fortunately, we have a second floor so we set up office space there and for the next 60 days, we worked out of there.

Conclusion: Today, we are finally back in the office, we have some great deals on retaining wall block and pavers, but are back in business fully. We would like to thank our customers for their support through some challenging times. In spite of the flood and the challenges it brought, we are on a roll to have a great year and owe our success to our customers.
